In the psychiatry community there is much confusion about how this applies to us. Almost all of us have an hourly rate that we disclose at the beginning of treatment. However, there are too many variables for us to estimate how long treatment will take. To me it would make sense that we have met the standard by disclosing our rate and that we can't predict the length. Psychotherapy much more than medical endeavors is based on a relationship where the two parties mutually decide the length of the treatment. Please clarify this in the final ruling so we know how to proceed.
