



APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION TO OFFER GAP WAIVERS

To apply for registration to offer Guaranteed Asset Protection waivers in the state of Washington, please provide information in the order requested on this application. This Office will promptly examine the application for completeness and compliance as prescribed by Washington requirements under chapter 48.160 RCW and chapter 284-160 WAC.

Prior to Submission:

Any person or entity must register with the commissioner before marketing, offering for sale or selling a guaranteed asset protection waiver, and before acting as an obligor for a guaranteed asset protection waiver, in this state.

Any person or entity is not required to register if the person or entity is a retail seller of motor vehicles that assigns more than eighty-five percent of guaranteed asset protection waiver agreements within thirty days of such agreements' effective date to a registered guaranteed asset protection waiver obligor, or the person or entity is an insurer authorized to transact such insurance business in this state.

Any person acting as an exempt creditor may elect to offer a guaranteed asset protection waiver that complies with certain sections under chapter 48.160 RCW.

RCW 48.160.080(1) precludes any person who markets, offers for sale or sells a guaranteed asset protection waiver, or acts as an obligor for a guaranteed asset protection waiver without a registration, unless otherwise exempt from registration or exempt from this chapter until you receive a registration.

This Office requires a complete application upon submission. If your application is missing information or documentation, we will allow a one-time extension of 15 business days to submit the required materials. If you are unable to correct the deficiencies within this period, we will deem the application materially incomplete and close the application. You may reapply when you are able to provide all required materials through a new application and application fee.

All information contained within your submission is a matter of public record under the Public Records Act. Any marking as "private" or "confidential" on any material does not preclude its availability or its status as a public record. See our [website](#) for more information about public records.

Application Submission

The current edition of the prescribed application form is required to ensure conformance with changes to laws and administrative rules. We will not accept prior versions of this application form.

Important!

Responsibility to understand [Chapter 48.160 RCW](#), [Chapter 284-160 WAC](#), and other applicable statutes, is that of the GAP waiver obligor. Any person, who markets, offers for sale or sells a GAP waiver, or acts as an obligor for a GAP waiver without a registration, unless exempt from registration or exempted from this chapter, is acting in violation of the statute and subject to the provisions of RCW 48.160.070. In addition, any person who knowingly violates the statute is guilty of a class B felony punishable under chapter 9A.20 RCW.

Once registered

Once registered, the applicant must keep the information required for registration current by reporting changes within thirty days after the end of the month in which the change occurs. Failure to make timely disclosure may result in disciplinary action against the registrant as allowed under Chapter 48.160 RCW.
